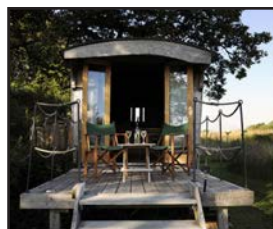

CELEBRATING 20 YEARS OF THE OAK FAIR

Many, many thanks to all involved with The Oak Fair over the last 20 years. It has been a fantastic experience from the acorn of an idea back in 2003 to this great show we have today.

My wife Josie and I took over Stock Estate exactly 25 years ago. After spending the first few years doing essential upgrades to the house like re-wiring and roof repairs (fire & water being the two big threats to old houses), we could see the many other projects that needed to be tackled.

The Ha-ha had collapsed, Breech Pit pond was silted up, the main lake leaked badly & there were many trees to plant. All these needed to be financed. The idea of an annual event came to mind that could perhaps fund a landscape project each year.

Living in a beautiful place like Stock, with our oak studded landscape that we are happy to share with visitors, the plan for a wood themed fair developed.

Having researched other shows and finding a gap in the summer calendar of events. I became convinced that it could work (though budgets suggested otherwise!). The final concept was simple; an enjoyable and affordable day out showcasing Dorset rural skills and good local food. All I had to do was persuade others to come and make it work!

With the help of Toria Wissett-Warner, we badgered and cajoled people to take stalls (free for the first year), and friends to manage car parking, ticketing and other show management jobs.

Thus, by the 27th August 2005 we had the basis of a show and with advertisements in local papers and roadside signs, perhaps some people would turn up.

Of the 86 original stalls that started with us, 9 are still here today, many thanks to them for their long term support. There are now over 200 stalls and demonstrators covering a much enlarged showground.

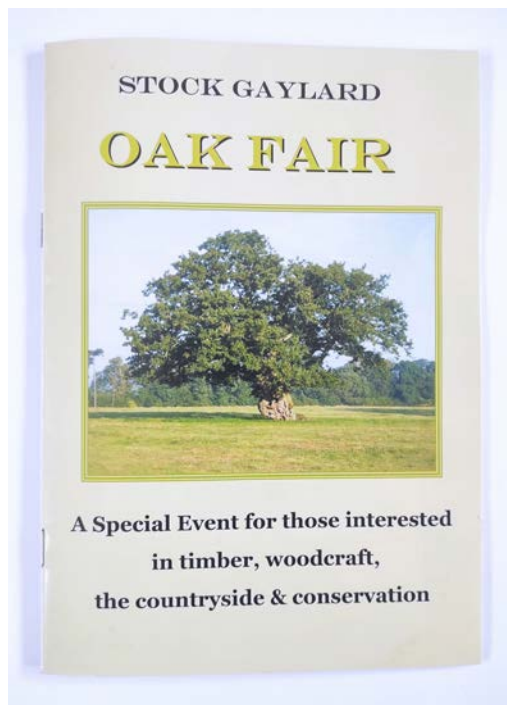

We are indebted to ALL who attend and maintain the friendly and knowledgably atmosphere that this show is known for. It is thanks to everyone who attends that we are able to repair and improve areas of this historic landscape that might otherwise fall into disrepair.
